

**Bay Zoltan Foundation's successful participation in the Jedlik Ányos Program
of the National Office for Research and Technology (NKTH), Hungary
Dec. 2007**

The decision about the grants of Jedlik Ányos Program has been announced. We are happy to inform the R&D community that the Bay Zoltan Foundation (BZAKA) won 591 million Ft in the following 6 projects in 3 main programs:

1. Sub program: Healthy Human

Infection prevention with nanotechnology

(Auro-Science Kft, **BZAKA-BAY-ATI**, Spektrum-3D Kft.; ZENON Europe Kft. SOTE).
Grant: 249,3 mFt, Foundation's share: 84,1 mFt.

Silvergate-112: Integrated approach of health system and social monitoring for improved life quality (Profilexpert Kft.; Innomed; BME; **BZAKA-BAY-IKTI**; ALBACOMP Zrt.).

Grant: 321,8 mFt, Foundation's share: 80,4 mFt.

New diagnostic and therapeutic methods for infusion drugs and prevention of anaphylaxis side effects (SeroScience Kft.; Diatron MI Zrt.; AdWare Research Kft.; **BZAKA-BAY-GEN, BZAKA-BAY-BIO**, SZTE, SOTE; SE).

Grant: 494,7 mFt, Foundation's share: 94,9 mFt.

2. Sub program: Competitive Industry

Shaped metal foam technology

Grant: 210 mFt, Foundation's share: 40,0 mFt.

Uniform collection and distribution of information in the national transport systems

Grant: 328,9 mFt, Foundation's share: 132,3 mFt.

4. Sub program: Sustainable environment

Production of raw materials by bio-purification for usage of polluted areas

Grant: 238,1 mFt, Foundation's share: 159,5 mFt.
